PRE-ENTRY COURSE REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST

- MATH COMPETENCY** *Within one year prior to nursing application period*
COMPASS test score in college math showing placement level *above* INTERMEDIATE ALGEBRA
- ENGLISH COMPOSITION** 5 college credits *No time limit*
Course # at SCC: ENGL& 101 (*ENG 101*) (*Prerequisite: ENGL 100 (ENG 100) or Satisfactory COMPASS test score*),
AND
- ENGLISH COMPETENCY** *Within one year prior to nursing application period*
COMPASS test score in reading and writing showing placement level at English 101
- GENERAL CHEMISTRY** 5 college credits *Within 10 years of application date*
Course # at SCC: CHEM& 121 (*CHEM 101*)
(Prerequisite: (MATH 099 and ENGL 100 (ENG 100) or higher)
- ANATOMY** 5 college credits *Within 5 years of application date*
Course # at SCC: BIOL& 231 (*BIOSC 210*)
(Prerequisite: BIOL& 211 (BIOSC 201))
- PHYSIOLOGY** 5 college credits *Within 5 years of application date*
Course # at SCC: BIOL& 232 (*BIOSC 211*)
(Prerequisite: BIOL& 211 (BIOSC 201) and BIOL& 231 (BIOSC 210))

Complete the classes below within the time frame described in the Nursing Brochure (or earlier) for additional points♦.
Completion of these courses before entering the Nursing Program is advised.

- MICROBIOLOGY**➤ 5 college credits *Within 5 years of application date*
Course # at SCC: BIOL& 260 (*BIOSC 215*)
(Prerequisite: BIOL& 211 (BIO 201) and CHEM& 121 (CHEM 101) recommended)
- NUTRITION**➤ 3-5 college credits
Course # at SCC: NUTR& 101 (*NDF 110*)
(Prerequisite: none .CHEM& 121 (CHEM 101) helpful.)
- LIFESPAN DEVELOPMENT**➤ 5 college credits
Course # at SCC: PSYC& 200 (*PSYCH 204*)
(Prerequisite: none.)
- QUANTITATIVE REASONING** 5 credits *(Prerequisites: see catalog course descriptions)*
Course #s at SCC: CHEM& 121 (*CHEM 101*) *fulfills this requirement.*
- FIRST AID** Course #s at SCC: PE 284 (*PE 292*) First Aid and CPR – nor required, but provides additional points for admission
- CPR** *Be certain you earn Health Care Provider, Health Professional, or Professional Rescuer CPR certification, if done elsewhere.* Course #s at SCC: PE 280 (*PE 191*) (Health Care Provider CPR)
If you take PE 284 (*PE 292*), be sure to tell your instructor that you need Healthcare Provider CPR as noted above.

**\*Take 5 credits if you plan to earn a four-year degree at some point in the future.**

➤ **Additional points are awarded if these courses are completed prior to applying to the program.**

Follow these easy steps...

- If you haven't applied to SCC before or haven't taken (credit) classes here, you must apply for college admission *for the current quarter* (not for when you plan to apply). If you were admitted to SCC in the past, please contact SCC Admissions to activate your file *for the current quarter*.

- If you haven't taken college level English or math, take the COMPASS English and math placement exam.  
**NOTE:** COMPASS testing is required for:  
1. Initial placement into college level English and math, **AND** for  
2. Application screening within one year of application to the Nursing Program to demonstrate competence at ENGL& 101 in reading and writing and above Intermediate Algebra for math.

- Attend a Nursing Program information session. - *not required but helpful to clarify questions*  
*Dates are listed each quarter on the **Applicant Information page** noted above*
- If you have attended other Washington state colleges, use the **Course Equivalence chart** from the Nursing Program **Applicant Information page** to assess which prerequisites you have credit for.  
**NOTE:** If you've attended out-of-state schools and have taken courses you think may apply to our pre-requisites, you must request a transcript evaluation and provide detailed course descriptions or syllabi. (*see next step*)
- Request a Transcript Evaluation -- *if necessary*. Most people with in-state courses can assess their pre-requisites using the **Course Equivalence chart** found on the **Applicant Information page**. The transcript evaluation form is available on the **Applicant Information page** noted above.  
**NOTE:** For transcript evaluation, print and complete the **Transcript Evaluation Request** form from the Nursing Program **Applicant Information page**, attach detailed course descriptions and a copy of your transcript; bring in or mail to the Nursing office. Allow 4 weeks for results to be mailed to you.
- If you've completed all of the above steps and have remaining questions, make an appointment for individual advising by calling 206-546-4559 *or* come to drop-in advising in building 2300 during the academic quarter. Schedule posted across from the main office  
Bring your unofficial transcripts, checklist, points calculation, and questions to the meeting.
- Complete pre-requisites as listed on the **Pre-Entry Checklist** found on the reverse of this page. (*Keep track of your points using the **Admissions Points System** in the **Nursing Brochure** or on the **Applicant Information page**.)*
- Apply to the nursing program!
